We are planning a visit to **Sandringham House and Gardens** on Thursday 25th May. The visit is an important part of our topic on Magnificent Monarchs, looking at the British monarchy from AD 871 to the present day, including King Charles' coronation. We will be having a guided tour of the house and a workshop on the coronation, giving valuable first hand experiences outside the classroom.
