In exploring and learning this week...

Happy New Year! The children have been very excited about our Fairies theme and have been busy looking for clues and writing letters. We have been busy making fairy doors and have even ordered tiny fairy numbers to 20. They were very enthusiastic about the trails of fairy dust they found as they came into school on Monday! We have used the text 'The Wychwood Fairies' as a starting point for talk and have been encouraging the children to ask questions.



What we will be looking at next week...

We will be continuing with our theme of 'fairies'. We hope to make some fairy cakes with the children and write recipes. We will also be making fairy potions, wands, making wishes, discovering fairy rings and will have a go at making fairy gardens. The children are keen to make fairy finding kits – will we ever get to see the Millfield Fairies?! The children will use these opportunities to explore measuring, capacity and as a starting point to stimulate talk and writing.
