We will challenge the children to find and make holes, e.g. key holes, animal homes and tunnels as well as using holes to explore threading, counting, cutting and measuring... Being such an open ended topic this could take us anywhere, we will have to wait and see!



The Big Challenge!

Collect some conkers with your child and use this as an opportunity to explore counting. Encourage your child to touch each conker as they count. Have a go at asking these questions. Who has got more/fewer? How many have we got altogether? How many will you have if I give you 2 more? This will help support your child's understanding of number and vocabulary such as more, fewer and altogether. Don't forget to share this with us on Tapestry!
