Please make payment through the online system [www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com) by 4<sup>th</sup> May.

We would very much like the visit to take place and hope that you will allow your child to participate and contribute towards the cost. In the exceptional circumstances of insufficient contributions being made, the School reserves the right to cancel the proposed visit and refund any money already received. **If any parents have difficulty in making a contribution for this trip, please see Mrs Bidecant in the school office.**

Children should wear normal uniform and an outdoor coat (weather depending). They will also require a packed lunch and drink. We will be departing in the morning and will return to school by the end of the school day.

Automatic consent for trips is given when you pay via Parentpay and therefore we do not require a slip to be returned unless you would like to be a parent helper. In the case of too many helpers, names will be pulled from a hat.
