Big Idea: Birds

We have had so much excellent exploring and learning during the two weeks we have spent on our Big Idea of Birds. We began by discovering everything about bird spotters, making our own bird hide, identifying birds by their feathers and songs, making different types of bird feeders, weighing and measuring bird seed, making nests in the mud kitchen and writing lots of bird fact books. We read the story Ssh We Have a Plan and practised our story telling skills in the small world. The children loved the story so much that we watched the "Shh! We have been reading the book I am Henry Finch and talking about positive self talk when we are feeling low. We even made our own thinking corner in the classroom with ideas of what to do when you feel sad e.g. remind yourself what you are good at, do some rainbow breathing, sing a song to yourself etc.. We were blown away by the children's ideas! Well done everyone!
