Our focus book this week has been 'Leaf man'. We have explored a number of activities such as creating our own leaf man or another animal on the light board using leaves, sticks and acorns. As the children really liked the jelly sensory tray when we explored spiders, we have decided to set different autumnal items in jelly for them to uncover using tweezers strengthening their fine motor skills. The children different explored seasonal vegetables; they cut them open using safety knives and investigated the textures and smells.
